

Breynia oblongifolia

Family : Euphorbiaceae

Habit : Open-branched shrub 2-4 m high.
Seems to sucker freely. Fruit red, 5-10 mm dia

Habitat : Seems to prefer sheltered situations, and areas where seepage could occur.
At GFP occurs as an understory plant in Eucalypt forest.

Collection site : GFP, in bush above clay flats.
